### HOW TO TRY OUT:

- 1. Go over this information with your parents and identify any conflicts you have with the rehearsal schedule.
- 2. Sign up for an audition time at <u>www.HillcrestTheatre.com</u> (the signups will be posted starting on Monday August 21)
- 3. On the day of your audition (Thursday August 24), fill out the online audition form (found at hillcresttheatre.com) on your phone or at home. Make sure you enter any rehearsal conflicts on that form.
- 4. Have your parent/guardian sign the permission sheet and bring it with you to your audition. If you're not able to have it with you at the audition on Thursday, email Mr. Long a picture of it signed by Thursday night (joshua.long@canyonsdistrict.org)
- 5. Show up for your audition at least 15 minutes prior to your assigned time.
- 6. Perform your monologue (60 seconds or less from a Shakespeare play) for Mr. Long and Mrs. Gremmert.
- 7. That's it!

### **Other information about the Shakespeare Team:**

- A cast list will be posted by the end of the night on Friday August 25 at www.HillcrestTheatre.com. The first team meeting and rehearsal will be Saturday morning August 26. There is no time to waste!
- The Shakespeare Competition will be held in Cedar City October 4-7. Anyone who makes the Competition Team will leave Wednesday, Oct. 4 after school and return Saturday, Oct. 7 late at night. All school absences on Thursday and Friday will be school excused.
- The trip will cost approximately \$400-500. This money will cover hotel, bus, registration fees, workshops, show tickets, some food, and team apparel. We do not know the final cost yet because hotel and transportation costs are fluctuating so much. We will keep the cost as cheap as we possibly can. This money will be due on Wednesday, Sept. 13.
- There is a small number of adult chaperones we can take on the trip. Adult chaperones will be decided on by the night of the Parent Meeting. If you are interested, contact Mr. Long. If your child has health or emotional needs that require special attention, it is suggested that a parent sign up to chaperone the trip.
- We do not want the financial obligation to hinder anyone from being on the team. If you are on fee waiver, your fee waiver DOES APPLY to this trip, so you're good to go. If you're not on fee waiver, but the financial aspect is still a concern, please talk to one of the theatre faculty as there may be some other scholarships available.
- There will be a mandatory Parents Meeting Wednesday, September 6 at 6:00pm.
- Individual Events (monologues and duo/trio scenes) will be cast from the students with the highest scores from the monologue auditions. All of these students will also be cast in the ensemble scene. The students selected to perform in or coach an Individual Event will have additional rehearsals outside of the Ensemble Scene rehearsals. If you do not feel you have the time to work on an individual event piece, please indicate in the appropriate place on your audition form.
- All Shakespeare Team members will perform their competition pieces as part of Hillcrest's 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Shakespeare Night on Monday, October 9 in the Auditorium.

# SHAKESPEARE TEAM Parent/Student commitment form

You/your child has auditioned for Hillcrest's 9-time defending national champion Shakespeare Team. Please note that not all students who audition will be selected for the team.

Students interested in being selected for the team must be able to commit to the rehearsal schedule provided. Any conflicts must be entered by the student on their digital form before they audition. Unless otherwise stated by Mr. Long, any dates entered in the student's conflict portion of their digital audition form will be considered excused absences. Otherwise, anyone on the team will be expected to be at all rehearsals they are called for.

All members of the Shakespeare Team will need to be available to travel to Cedar City for the Shakespeare Competition Oct. 4-7. If your child has health or emotional needs that require special attention, it is suggested that a parent sign up to chaperone the trip.

There will be a trip fee if your student is chosen to be on the team. This fee will be approximately \$400-500 (depending on possible bus prices). This money will cover hotel, show tickets, registration fees, workshops, some food, team apparel, and bus fees. This money will be due on Wednesday, Sept. 13. Fee waivers DO apply this year. We do not want the financial aspect to be an obstacle to students participating on the team. Please contact a member of the Theatre Department faculty for possible scholarship opportunities.
